

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

Media Borough Council met in the large conference room of the Media Municipal Center on the above date with the following officials present: President Daly, Councilmen Williamson, Derrickson and Alyanakian. Borough Manager Smith was also in attendance.

President Daly called the public hearing to order at 7:10 p.m.

UTILIZATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2008 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS

Borough Manager Smith highlighted the (2) proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications.

The first application pertains to road resurfacing improvements to Jefferson, Mott, Worall, Jasper Streets and Pennock Place. This includes the milling and resurfacing of the streets, replacing curbing, sidewalks and aprons, upgrading street lights, replacing signage in the amount of \$73,205.10.

The other application pertains to Olive and Jefferson Streets storm sewer improvements in the amount of \$237,090.65. The Olive and Jefferson Street storm sewer improvement project will attempt to mitigate/eliminate flooding in this location and the surrounding homes.


PUBLIC COMMENT & PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR
