

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
December 4, 2008

Media Borough Council met in the large conference room of the Media Municipal Center on the above date with the following officials present: Mayor McMahon, President Daly, Vice-President Hall, Councilmen Cunningham, Williamson, Derrickson and Alyanakian. Borough Manager Smith and Engineer Walton were also in attendance. Councilwoman Simpson was absent from the meeting.

President Daly called the Public Hearing to order at 7:10 p.m.

FY2009 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATIONS

President Daly deferred to Councilman Derrickson and Engineer Walton to highlight the FY2009 Community Development Block Grant applications. Engineer Walton explained that he updated the applications as follows: \$99,000 for road resurfacing and \$295,000 for stormwater drainage at Olive & Jefferson Streets. Engineer Walton mentioned that the Borough may want to consider breaking down the road resurfacing into phases since the Borough has not been successful in applying for Community Development Block Grant funds in the past. It was determined that the Borough has not been successful for approximately 10 years with regard to Community Development Block Grant applications.

Councilman Cunningham suggested that \$111,130 for the design of the Third Street Bridge be included as an application for Community Development Block Grant funds. Borough officials will attempt to determine if this is an eligible project under the Community Development Block Grant regulations.
