

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
June 18, 2009

Media Borough Council met in the large conference room of the Media Municipal Center on the above date with the following officials present: Mayor McMahon, President Daly, Vice-President Hall, Councilwoman Simpson, Councilmen Cunningham, Williamson, Derrickson and Alyanakian. Borough Manager Smith and Solicitor Scott were also in attendance.

President Daly called the Public Hearing to order at 7:45 p.m.

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

Councilman Williamson summarized the proposed Stormwater Management Ordinance amending Chapter 251 (Stormwater Management) of the Media Borough Code to provide an exemption from the drainage plan submission and other requirements of the ordinance for regulated activities which result in 300 square feet or less of new impervious cover in connection with a structure used for a single-family residence provided that the owner of the property either (i) plants a tree or (ii) provides a rain barrel.

Councilman Alyanakian mentioned this ordinance is a positive step since he believes having no exemptions is onerous to residents.

Councilman Cunningham mentioned that he will comment on this ordinance during the regular meeting this evening.


PUBLIC COMMENT & PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR
