PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

A Public Hearing was held on the above date with the following officials present: Vice-President Robinson, Borough Manager Smith and Judy Fowler, Grants Administrator.

Vice-President Robinson called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m.

RESOLUTION #2004-16 - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
APPLICATION

Borough Manager Smith summarized the proposed projects for CDBG funding for FY 2005. The projects include road resurfacing and Jefferson/Olive Street storm sewer improvements.


Borough Manager Smith stated the following roads are proposed for 2005 CDBG funding: Jefferson Street (from Lemon Street to the end of the cul-de-sac), Mott Street, Worrall Street (from Providence Road to Manchester Avenue), Jasper Street (from Radnor Street to Manchester Avenue), and Pennock Place. Borough Manager Smith explained that the project is necessary to remedy the current deteriorated conditions of some of the roads in Media. The proposed work includes milling and resurfacing. The Borough is requesting \$187,527.00 of CDBG funds to supplement a local contribution of \$26,254.00. The total cost of the project is \$213,781.00.

Borough Manager Smith summarized the project application for storm sewer improvements on Olive and Jefferson Streets, stating this infrastructure project will eliminate flooding at Olive and Jefferson Streets and surrounding homes with the installation of new storm water inlets and pipes to increase flood control. The Borough is requesting \$157,725.00 of CDBG funds to supplement a local contribution of \$22,085.00. The total project cost is \$179,810.00.

There were no public comments.

Vice-President Robinson made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing. The Public Hearing adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
