

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
December 7, 2006

Media Borough Council met in the large conference room of the Media Municipal Center on the above date with the following officials present: President Daly, Vice-President Hall, Councilpersons Simpson and Derrickson. Borough Manager Smith, Engineer Walton, Police Chief Wusinich and Grants Administrator Fowler were also in attendance.

President Daly called the special meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

UTILIZATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2007 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS

Judy Fowler, Grants Administrator, highlighted the two (2) proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications.

The first application pertains to road resurfacing improvements to Jefferson, Mott, Worall, Jasper Streets and Pennock Place. This includes the milling and resurfacing of the streets as well as replacing the curbing, sidewalks and aprons, upgrading street lights and replacing signage in the amount of \$173,051.95.

The other application pertains to Olive and Jefferson Streets storm sewer improvements in the amount of \$219,362.67. Engineer Walton mentioned that the stormwater from the Delaware County Court House Complex flows down to the intersection of Olive and Jefferson Streets. It appears that the County of Delaware does not have adequate facilities for stormwater management.

President Daly noted that the Borough has applied unsuccessfully for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the past three (3) years. Previously, CDBG funds in the amount of approximately \$200,000 have been received by the Pennsylvania Veterans Museum Board for the museum, which is located in the Armory building. Additional funding in the amount of \$150,000 has been received by the Society for the Performing Arts for roof repairs at the Media Theatre. While both projects were worthwhile, President Daly believes that the Borough is due funding for the above referenced projects.

The Public Hearing adjourned at 7:20 p.m. on a motion by Vice-President Hall, seconded by Councilwoman Simpson.
