

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

August 6, 2009

Media Borough Council met in the large conference room of the Media Municipal Center on the above date with the following officials present: Mayor McMahon, President Daly, Vice-President Hall, Councilmen Cunningham, Williamson, Derrickson and Alyanakian. Borough Manager Smith and Solicitor Scott were also in attendance. Councilwoman Simpson was absent from the meeting.

President Daly called the Public Hearing to order at 7:35 p.m.

INTER-MUNICIPAL TRANSFER OF A LIQUOR LICENSE – 8 W. STATE STREET

John McCreesh, attorney for Michele Colandrea of Little Anthony's, mentioned his client's petition for the inter-municipal transfer of a liquor license at 8 W. State Street to sell beer only. Mr. McCreesh introduced Mr. Colandrea in order to discuss the particulars of this petition.

Mr. Colandrea indicated that his restaurant seats approximately 70-80 customers and serves pizza, sandwiches, etc. Mr. Colandrea wishes to sell beer and believes it is essential to add this due to the economy. Mr. Colandrea indicated that sixty percent (60%) of his customers eat in the restaurant and forty percent (40%) of the business is take out. He mentioned seventy-five percent (75%) of Little Anthony's customer base is over 21 years of age. There will be no bar set up in the restaurant and they will only sell beer.

Mr. McCreesh mentioned that Council has the ability to turn down such liquor license petitions and it is not appealable.

Mr. McCreesh and Mr. Colandrea are agreeable to conditions on approval of the inter-municipal transfer of a liquor license for 8 W. State Street.


PUBLIC COMMENT & PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR
