Borough Manager Smith mentioned that municipalities have to submit their Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications by the middle of January and are required under federal guidelines to conduct a public hearing for those requests. Borough Manager Smith mentioned that this would include low to moderate income areas. Borough Manager Smith mentioned that in previous years the Borough has submitted requests for the Third Street Bridge/Dam, handicapped ramps, an elevator for the Borough Hall, generator at Borough Hall, etc. Councilman Williamson mentioned that since the last full update to the comprehensive plan was in 1987, Council should consider this the first request. Councilman Williamson mentioned that Council should consider installing sidewalks where there are none. Councilman Williamson thanked Councilman Cunningham for his work on the list of qualified areas. Councilwoman Simpson mentioned that she would request a back-up generator and elevator for the Borough Hall. Borough Manager Smith mentioned that the approximate cost for the elevator would be \$207,000 and the cost for the generator and impact resistant windows would be approximately \$119,900. Vice-President Rehoric mentioned that the generator would be her first request. Engineer Walton mentioned that other municipalities have qualified for up to a \$500,000 grant through turn back funds. Council agreed that the first request will be for the comprehensive plan and the second request will be for the generator and impact resistant windows. Council will consider submitting a request for the elevator and repair of sidewalks through the turn back funds in 2011.


