

**BOROUGH OF MEDIA  
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES  
JUNE 18, 2020**

Media Borough Council met via Zoom and streaming live on YouTube on the above date with the following officials present: Mayor McMahon, President Hall, Vice-President A. Johnson, Councilmen Boyer, Robinson and Williamson, Councilwomen Dixon and L. Johnson. Also present were Manager Smith, Solicitor Scott.

President Hall called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

President Hall summarized the process pertaining to the inter-municipal transfer of a liquor license. President Hall mentioned a letter of request for a liquor license transfer was received from the tenant of 11-13 West State Street for the purpose of the current restaurant serving alcohol.

John McCreesh, III, attorney for the applicant, briefly discussed the intentions of the restaurant owner. The owner would like to supplement the food menu with a wine bar. The restaurant will have a small bar, which will seat eight (8) customers. Mr. McCreesh mentioned the restaurant owner is agreeable to no more than 35% being liquor and no advertisement of liquor will be placed on the windows. Mr. McCreesh mentioned the applicants have no history of violations and are RAMP approved.

There were no comments.

President Hall made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing. Councilman Robinson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. The Public Hearing adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
