**EMERGENCY DELCARATION FOR MEDIA BOROUGH  
BECAUSE OF THE EFFECTS OF THE COVID-19  
CORONAVIRUS**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the authority vested by 35 Pa.C.S.A. § 7501(b), the Mayor is authorized to declare emergencies because of the severe damage anticipated to be caused by the effects of the COVID-19 Coronavirus in the Borough.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DECLARED**, by the Mayor of the Borough of Media, County of Delaware, Pennsylvania, that:

1. The effects of the COVID-19 Coronavirus in the Borough constitute a clear and present danger to life or property.
2. The Disaster Emergency declared for the Borough under 35 Pa.C.S.A. § 7501(b) by the Mayor and the resulting enabling of the provisions of 35 Pa.C.S.A. § 7501 shall continue until further action is taken by the Mayor of the Borough Council to declare the end of such Disaster Emergency.

**A RESOLUTION OF MEDIA BOROUGH, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA EXTENDING DIASTER  
DECLARATION INSTITUTED ON MARCH 13, 2020 PERTAINING TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

**WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2020, Governor Wolf declared a disaster emergency in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania pertaining to the Covid-19 pandemic (the "State Declaration"); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2020, Mayor Robert McMahon declared a disaster emergency in Media Borough pertaining to the Covid-19 pandemic (the "Local Declaration"); and


**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Act, 35 P.S. § 7501(b) states that ratification by a governing body is required to extend a local disaster emergency declaration beyond seven (7) days; and

**WHEREAS**, the Covid-19 pandemic is an ongoing disaster emergency, the end of which cannot be predicted by Media Borough Council and Mayor McMahon at this time;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT,**

1. Ratification of Disaster Emergency Declaration. The Local Declaration made by Mayor McMahon on March 13, 2020 is hereby ratified.
2. Term of Emergency Declaration. The Local Declaration shall remain in place until the Borough Council discontinues the State Declaration.
